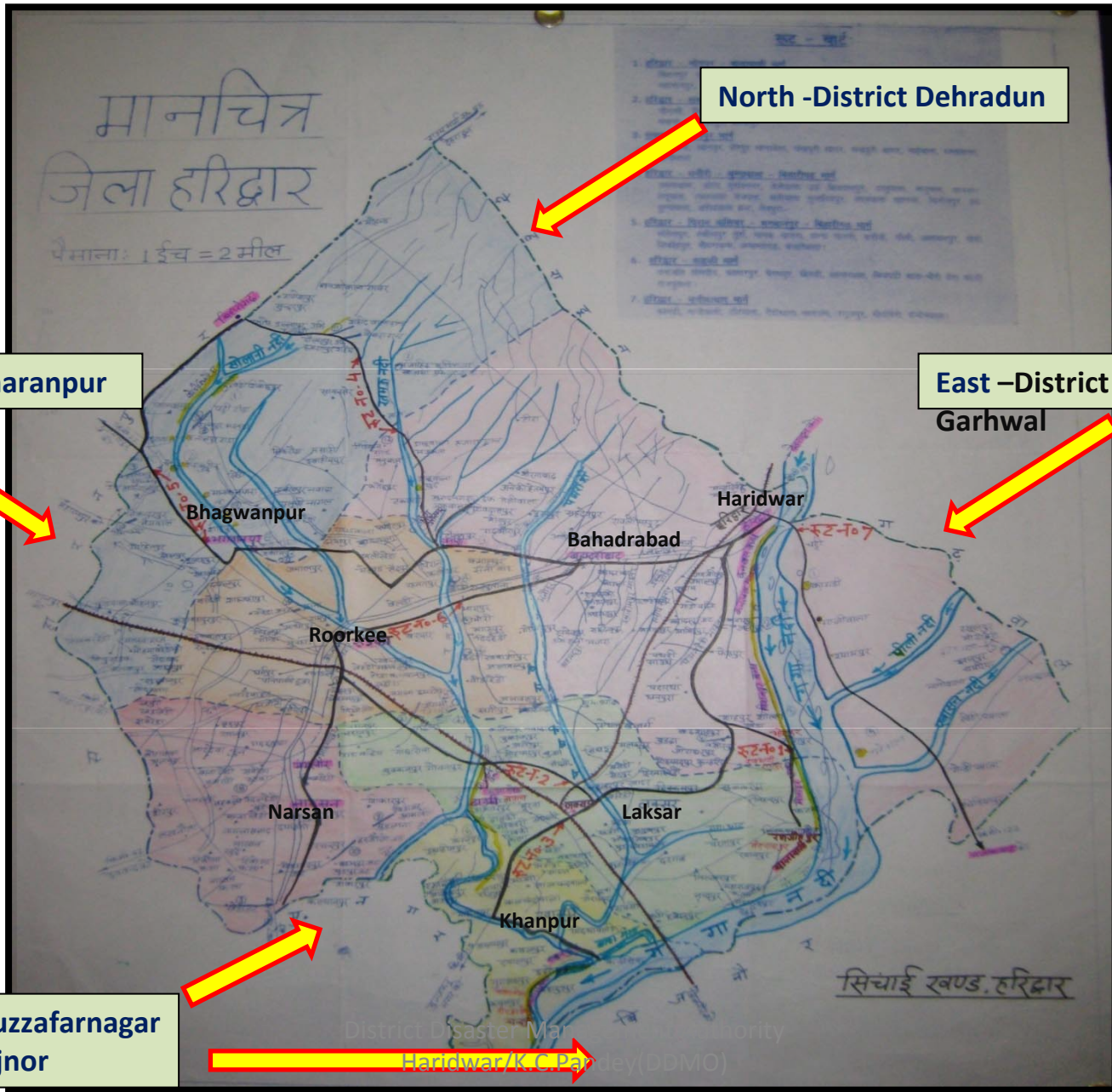

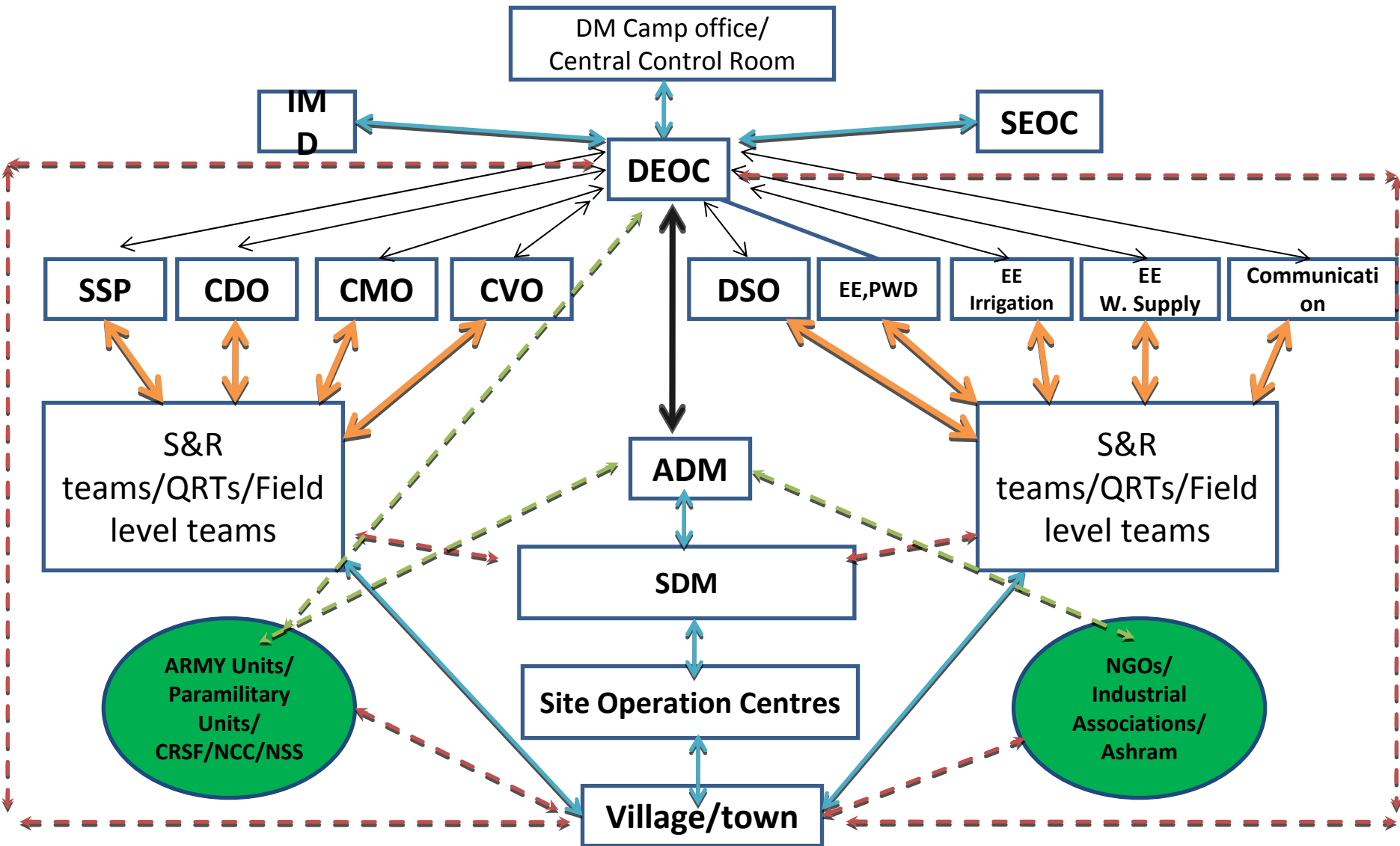

Indian Disaster Resource Network (IDRN)

- To collect information and prepare a Database for all trained human resource, mechanical resource and equipments available with the district, IDRN resource collection format has been circulated to all the Government departments, PSUs, Army unit, Industries and NGOs.
- The collected information is being uploaded to the IDRN site on regular intervals.

Department level Disaster Management Action Plan

Every department of the district is oriented to prepare departmental level Disaster Management Action Plan and Disaster management team for which a Format also been circulated to every department.

Response Mechanism during Disaster

- **Communication/warning**

On the basis of warning from the competent agencies or on the receipt of warning or alert from State Emergency Operations Centre or DECO the **District Magistrate Haridwar** will exercise the powers and responsibilities of the **Chairman of District Disaster Management Authority**.

The immediate alert warning will be communicated to...

- **Chief Secretary, GoU**
- **Divisional Commissioner, Garhwal**
- **All desk officers**
- **All district level officials, Municipal Councils**
- **MPs, MLAs, Chairman Nagar Palika Parishad, ZP President,**
- **Local units of the Defence Services, CISF, PAC**

The occurrence of the disaster would essentially bring into force the following....

- The District Collector will **activate the District Emergency Operation Centre**
- All desk officers will be on their respective Desks and will start to mobilize their teams to the spot.
- **All district level staff from various departments will be under the direction and control of the District Magistrate .**
- **Leave of all the officers of the district level and staff would automatically stand cancelled and the organizations would direct their staff to report on duty immediately.**
- The Chief Secretary is the controlling authority in respect of Grants under “2245-Relief on account of Natural Calamities and also Loans and Advances”. **He shall, therefore, ensure that adequate grants are placed at the disposal of the District Magistrate under these budget heads and that implementation of relief and rehabilitation measures is not hampered on account of paucity of funds or otherwise.**

- The DM may in case of large-scale disasters get in touch with the local Defence units for assistance for rescue, evacuation and emergency relief measures.
- The DM will have the **authority to requisite resources, materials and equipments from the private sector.**
- The DM will have the power to direct the **industry to activate their on-site or off-site disaster management plan.**
- The DM will set-up **Site Operation Centre/s** in the affected area with the desk arrangements.
- The DM will authorize establishment of **transit and /or relief camps, feeding centres and cattle camps.**
- An on-going wireless communication and **contact from the DEOC to the Site Operation Centres, Transit Camps, Feeding Centres, Relief Camps and Cattle Camps will be activated.**
- DEOC will send the Preliminary Information Report and Action Taken Report, as per the available information, to the Chief Secretary/Relief Commissioner/Emergency Operation Centre and the Divisional Commissioner.

- The DM will authorize immediate evacuation whenever necessary.
- In the event of **possibilities of the disasters in the adjoining districts, including those beyond the state borders, the DM will issue the alert warning to them.**
- In the absence of the District Magistrate, **Additional District Magistrate** will officiate and exercise all the powers and responsibilities of the DM listed above.

SITE OPERATION CENTRES

- Depending on the nature of disaster and the type of damage, **it may be necessary to set up a number of relief camps and/or cattle camps. In such a situation, the DM may decide to set-up a Site Operations Centre (SOCs) to reduce the pressure on District Control Room for field coordination.**
- The Site Operations Centre will be managed by **Sub Divisional Magistrates.**
